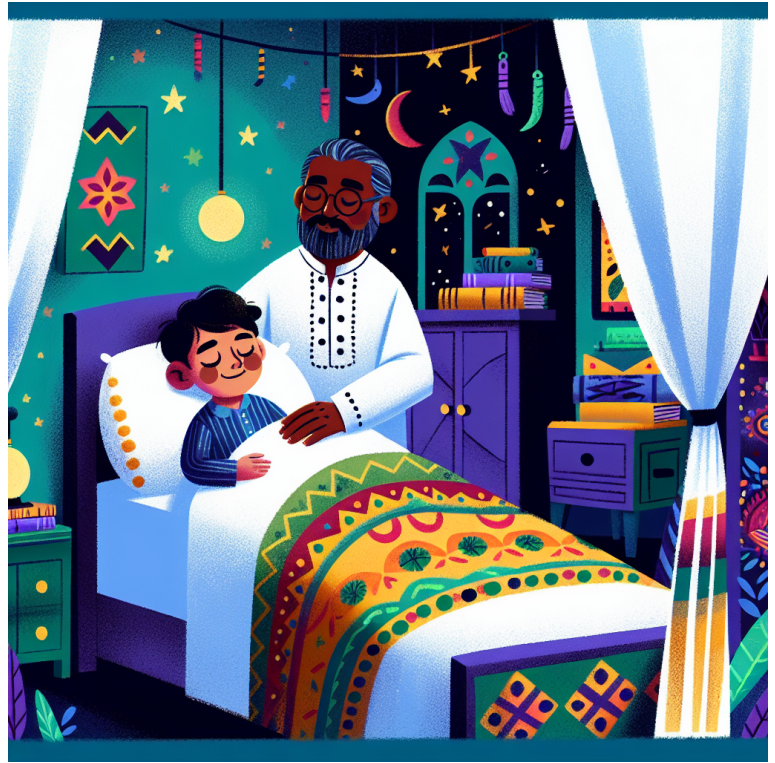
Timmy put on his helmet, and they zoomed up and down the street on the scooter. The cool evening breeze made the ride even more enjoyable.
