
The Bowl of Yogurt and the Great Mosque

A long time ago, in a land far away, lived a great ruler named Suleiman the Magnificent. Suleiman wanted to build a grand mosque for everyone to visit and pray.




He told all the builders, 'Do not accept help from anyone! This is my special project.' The workers worked hard every day to build the beautiful mosque.

The old woman gave her bowl of yogurt to the workers. They remembered the Sultan's orders but couldn't refuse her kindness.




That night, Suleiman had a dream. He saw a big scale. On one side was the grand mosque, and on the other side was the grandmother's bowl of yogurt.




To his surprise, the bowl of yogurt weighed more than the mosque! In the morning, Suleiman went to the workers.
